**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The proposed Climate Compass is a comprehensive update to the City of Elk Grove's current Climate Action Plan (CAP), adopted in 2019. The proposed Plan establishes a roadmap for the City to achieve its


greenhouse gas (GHG) emission reduction targets and includes actions and strategies to adapt to anticipated climate-related impacts. In addition, the Plan aligns local efforts with Assembly Bill (AB) 1279 (2021-22 Legislative Session), which requires California to achieve net-zero GHG emissions and an 85 percent reduction in anthropogenic GHG emissions by 2045.

This is to advise that on **June 10, 2026**, the City of Elk Grove City Council has approved the above-described Project and has made the following determinations regarding the above-described project.
