1 Arrival Experience

- Calm, dignified, and non-institutional
- Single, well-defined entry point
- Windows at the lobby, reception, and staff work areas, providing natural monitoring of the arrival zone
- Primary hub of coordination

2 Site Security

- Overhead site lighting throughout the perimeter of the property
- Camera surveillance
- Clear lines of sight from staff areas to all major outdoor spaces
- Controlled public-facing zones and protected resident-only areas

3 Landscape Frontage

- Native drought tolerant landscaping
- Storm retention basin
- Elevated planter beds to scale down and soften internal courtyard walls

4 Secured Outdoor Courtyard

- Private outdoor space with shade coverings, dog walk, isolated children's play area, landscaping and solid fencing
- Designated dog park area

5 Onsite Parking

- For employees and sheltered individuals

Design Highlights

- Warm, welcoming shelter designed with a residential character that fosters dignity and a sense of home
- Simple sloped roof forms and soft neutral materials to create a familiar, non-institutional presence
- Large windows throughout shared and resident spaces to maximize natural daylight, visibility, and comfort
- Compact, efficiently organized site layout that optimizes limited footprint without sacrificing functionality
- Clear and intuitive program adjacencies to support ease of navigation and daily operations
- Strong indoor-outdoor connections centered on a secure interior courtyard
- Courtyard designed as a protected outdoor room for small gatherings, recreation, and quiet respite
- Flexible multipurpose space supporting meetings, workshops, dining overflow
- Direct multipurpose room access to the secured courtyard to expand usable space and enable indoor-outdoor programming
- Emphasis on safety, privacy, and comfort while maximizing usable area on a constrained site
