Subject: Road Construction Moratorium for the Holiday - Reminder Notice

The holiday season is just around the corner, and the City of Elk Grove will institute a construction moratorium on selected City Streets starting Monday, November 24, 2025 through Sunday, November 30, 2025 and Thursday, December 18, 2025 through Thursday, January 01, 2026 in accordance with updated Section 7-8.06 of the Standard Construction Specifications. Unless specifically approved by the Public Works Director or his designee, all construction activities and house structure moves, occurring between the hours of 7:00 AM and 10:00 PM, that interfere with public traffic on specific City Streets (see enclosed table and map) will be restricted. Construction activities and house structure moves pertaining to these specific streets shall be completed prior to the moratorium or postponed.

Emergency repairs will be allowed, as set forth in Section 7-8.06 of the Standard Construction Specifications. Please send emergency work notifications to pwpermits@elkgrovecity.org and contact Naweed Ataie, Public Works Inspector, regarding repairs within one hour of your start time at 916-627-3422 and/or nataie@elkgrovecity.org

Update:

1. Modification to Standard Construction Specifications:
 - a. Section 7-8.06-Lane and Road Closures During November/December Holiday Season, reduced holiday season from six weeks to two weeks (Monday before Thanksgiving to the Sunday after and 5 business days before Christmas Day through the first business day in January).

Effect of Update:

1. This modification will reduce the moratorium period to from six weeks (Thanksgiving holiday to New Years holiday) to two weeks (the weeks of Thanksgiving and Christmas only) to allow construction work and project schedules to commence during the non-peak traffic weeks within the holiday season.

7-8.06 Lane and Road Closures During November/December Holiday Season

Except as provided in the Special Provisions or approved by the City, construction will be suspended and no activities that interfere with public traffic shall be conducted on the designated streets during the holiday season (defined as the Monday before Thanksgiving through the Sunday after Thanksgiving and five business days before Christmas Day through the first business day in January). All existing pits, excavations, trenches, and openings in the road surface shall be backfilled and paved to produce a level and smooth surface. All construction area traffic control devices, as defined in Section 12 of these specifications, shall be removed from all traffic lanes, unless authorized by the City as long-term traffic controls. Only emergency repairs as defined in Section 7-8.03, "Emergency Repairs", in this Section of these Specifications will be permitted during the holiday season.

The moratorium streets and roadway segments impacted by this moratorium are listed in the following table.

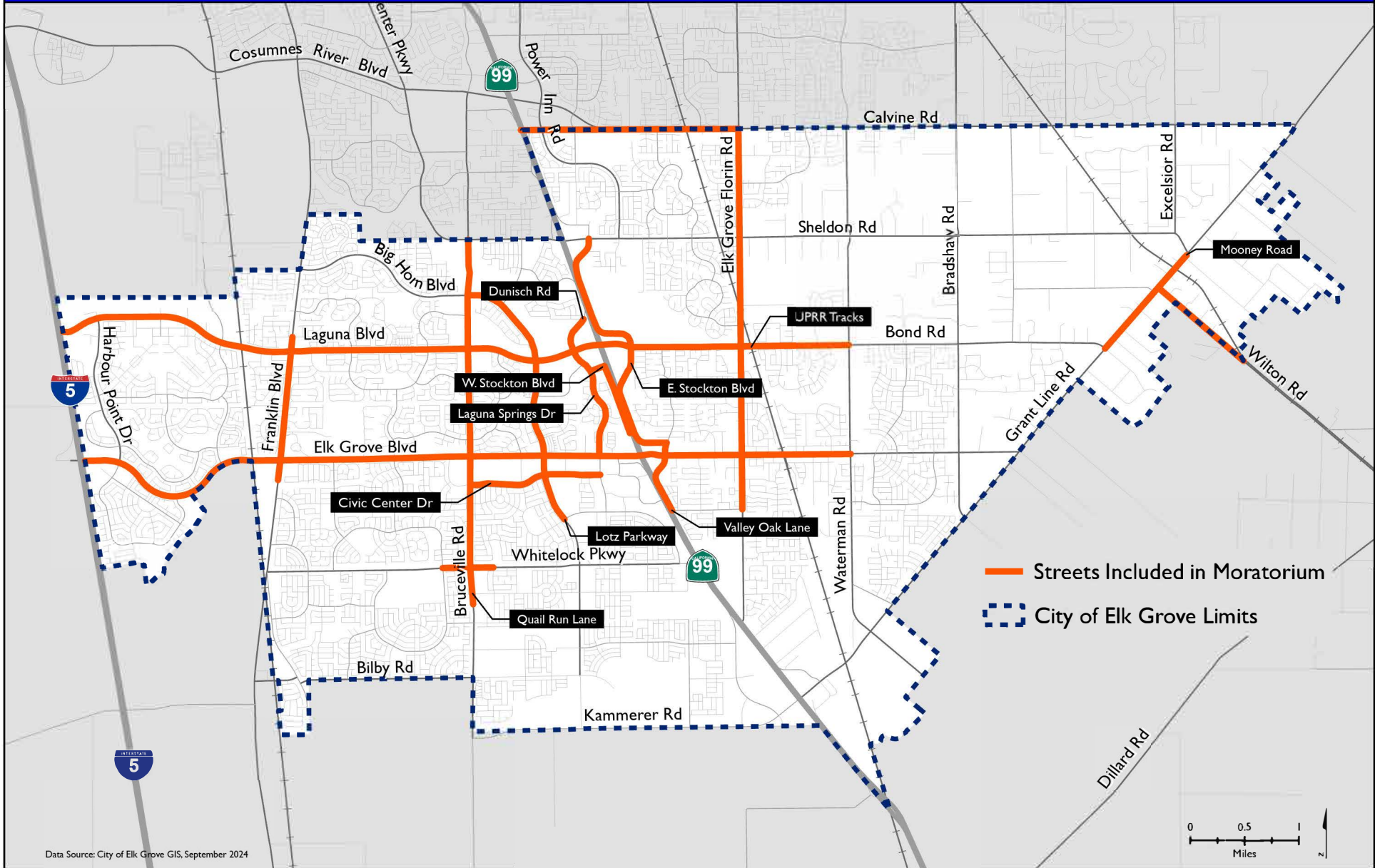
