

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-028

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A REIMBURSEMENT
AGREEMENT WITH THE SACRAMENTO COUNTY WATER AGENCY RELATED TO
THE CAPITAL PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE PROGRAM (CEQA EXEMPT)**

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove (City) desires to schedule streets for pavement maintenance outlined in the City's Capital Pavement Maintenance Program (Program); and

WHEREAS, the Program will be implemented through several phases of work bid as separate projects each year; and

WHEREAS, the Sacramento County Water Agency (SCWA) owns and manages several utility boxes within the City that will need to be raised or lowered to align with the new height of the adjacent roadway as a result of the annual Program projects; and


WHEREAS, completing the utility box modifications as part of the annual pavement maintenance construction projects will reduce inconveniences to residents and improve project efficiency; and


WHEREAS, the execution of a Reimbursement Agreement with the Sacramento County Water Agency related to the Capital Pavement Maintenance Program is not considered a "project" under CEQA, per CEQA Guideline 15378.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

1. Finds that the execution of the Reimbursement Agreement with the Sacramento County Water Agency related to the Capital Pavement Maintenance Program does not constitute a "project" under CEQA, per CEQA Guideline 15378, because the execution of the agreement will not itself result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment. Utility box improvements will be implemented through future construction contracts, for which CEQA applicability and level of analysis will be assessed once the utility box improvements and locations have been determined; and
2. Authorizes the City Manager to execute the Reimbursement Agreement with the Sacramento County Water Agency, in substantially the form presented, for reimbursement of costs to modify SCWA utility boxes located within the City limits and impacted by the City's annual Pavement Maintenance Program projects for a five-year term.
