

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-049

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCEDURE PURSUANT TO ELK
GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.180(B)(3) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY
MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH FOLSOM LAKE FORD, INC. A
CALIFORNIA CORPORATION, FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE ADDITIONAL AND
SIX REPLACEMENT POLICE VEHICLES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
\$391,535.62**

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove's Fleet Services maintains all City vehicles and procures replacements and additional vehicles when necessary; and

WHEREAS, Fleet Services has identified six Police vehicles that will have reached the end of their useful life of City service in Fiscal Year (FY) 2025-26; and

WHEREAS, the City's Police Department has been approved to allocate funds from the California Office of Traffic Safety Selective Traffic Enforcement Programs Grant for the purchase of one additional Police vehicle to accommodate increased staffing and vehicle needs; and

WHEREAS, current economic conditions, including supply chain and manufacturing delays are creating long lead times for the order and receipt of pursuit-rated vehicles; and

WHEREAS, to mitigate these delays and ensure the Police Department has safe and reliable vehicles to serve the community, staff is recommending the purchase of one additional and six replacement Police vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the State of California opened a competitive bidding process for the purchase of pursuit-rated Ford Utility Police Interceptors in 2022; and

WHEREAS, Folsom Lake Ford, Inc., a California corporation (Folsom Lake Ford), was awarded the State of California's large quantity contract for pursuit-rated Ford Police Interceptor vehicles, which was competitively bid and Folsom Lake Ford will honor such state-contract pricing in sales of vehicles to the City; thus, the City is receiving a competitive price and the expenditures of staff time to compile the necessary bid documents a second time for a small number of vehicles will not likely result in a better price or an outcome more advantageous to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

1. Finds that a formal bidding procedure is not in the best interest of the City and dispenses with the formal bidding procedure for the subject vehicles pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.180(B)(3) and authorizes the purchase of the subject vehicles pursuant to the terms and conditions of the competitively-bid State of California Contract #1-22-23-14C; and
2. Authorizes the City Manager to execute a contract with Folsom Lake Ford, in substantially the form presented, for the purchase of one additional and six replacement Police vehicles in an amount not to exceed \$391,535.62.


