

## RESOLUTION NO. 2025-051

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING THE 2025 PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE PROJECT – PAVEMENT REPAIRS (WPR025); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH CENTRAL VALLEY ENGINEERING & ASPHALT, INC. FOR THE PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,559,269; AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS NOT-TO-EXCEED \$155,927; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH THE SECOND LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER IF THE FIRST LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER DOES NOT MEET FILING OBLIGATIONS (CEQA EXEMPT)**

**WHEREAS**, the 2025 Pavement Maintenance Project – Pavement Repairs (WPR025) (Project) will result in the repair of over 246,000 square feet of existing Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement at various locations throughout the City; and

**WHEREAS**, an invitation to bid was duly advertised on January 24, 2025, and January 31, 2025, and electronic bids were received on February 20, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, Central Valley Engineering & Asphalt, Inc. was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid; and

**WHEREAS**, United Pavement Maintenance, Inc. was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the second lowest responsive bid; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project is a project under California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000 et seq. of the Public Resources Code, hereinafter referred to as CEQA) which requires that cities consider the environmental consequences of their actions before approving a project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project is included in the approved 2024-2029 Capital Improvement Program and is budgeted with funds in the approved Fiscal Year 2024-25 Budget.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Finds the 2025 Pavement Maintenance Project – Pavement Repairs (WPR025) exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15301 (existing facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines based upon the following finding:

Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines (Chapter 3 of Division 6 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations) provides an exemption from CEQA for projects involving the minor alteration of existing public or private facilities when the alteration involves negligible or no expansion of an existing use. The Project involves repairing existing pavement at various locations throughout the City. The proposed improvements would occur within existing City-owned infrastructure and would not add any additional vehicle travel lanes; therefore, the Project would result in no expansion of use and qualifies for the identified exemption. No additional environmental review under CEQA is required.; and


- 2) Approves the Project; and
- 3) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Central Valley Engineering & Asphalt, Inc. for the 2025 Pavement Maintenance Project – Pavement Repairs (WPR025) in the amount of \$1,559,269 upon receipt of all required bonds and insurance and the approval of such bonds and insurance by the City Attorney; and,
- 4) Authorizes the Public Works Director to approve change orders not-to-exceed \$155,927; and,
- 5) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with the second lowest responsive bidder, United Pavement Maintenance, Inc., if Central Valley Engineering & Asphalt, Inc. does not meet filing obligations.
