

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-068

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING THE 2025 PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE PROJECT – SLURRY SEAL AND PAVEMENT RESURFACING (WPR025); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH AMERICAN PAVEMENT SYSTEMS INC. FOR THE PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,469,991.48; AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS NOT TO EXCEED \$347,000; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH THE SECOND LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER IF THE FIRST LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER DOES NOT MEET FILING OBLIGATIONS (CEQA EXEMPT)

WHEREAS, the 2025 Pavement Maintenance Project – Slurry Seal and Pavement Resurfacing (WPR025) (Project) includes slurry seal, micro-surfacing, two-layer treatment system, adjusting utility frames and covers, and re-stripping various streets throughout the City (Work); and

WHEREAS, an invitation to bid was duly advertised on February 28, 2025, and March 7, 2025, and electronic bids were received on March 27, 2025; and

WHEREAS, American Pavement Systems Inc. was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, Pavement Coatings Co. was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the second lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, the Project is a project under California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000 et seq. of the Public Resources Code, hereinafter referred to as CEQA), which requires that cities consider the environmental consequences of their actions before approving a project; and

WHEREAS, the Project is included in the approved 2024-2029 Capital Improvement Program and is budgeted with funds in the approved Fiscal Year 2024-25 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Finds the 2025 Pavement Maintenance Project – Slurry Seal and Pavement Resurfacing (WPR025) exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15301 (existing facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines based upon the following finding:

Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines (Chapter 3 of Division 6 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations) provides an exemption from CEQA for projects involving the minor alteration of existing public or private facilities when the alteration involves negligible or no expansion of an existing use. The Project involves surface treatments on over 6.7 million square feet of streets. Surface treatments include slurry seal, microsurfacing, and two-layer treatment system at various locations throughout the City. The proposed improvements would occur within existing City-owned infrastructure

and would not add any additional vehicle travel lanes; therefore, the Project would result in no expansion of use and qualifies for the identified exemption. No additional environmental review under CEQA is required.


- 2) Approves the Project.
- 3) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with American Pavement Systems Inc. for the 2025 Pavement Maintenance Project – Slurry Seal and Pavement Resurfacing (WPR025) in the amount of \$3,469,991.48 upon receipt of all required bonds and insurance and the approval of such bonds and insurance by the City Attorney.
- 4) Authorizes the Public Works Director to approve change orders not to exceed \$347,000.
- 5) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with the second lowest responsive bidder, Pavement Coatings Co., if American Pavement Systems Inc. does not meet filing obligations.
