

**RESOLUTION NO. 2025-065**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE  
DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCEDURE PURSUANT TO ELK  
GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.180(B)(3) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH 72 HOUR LLC, DBA WATSONVILLE  
FLEET GROUP, A CALIFORNIA CORPORATION, FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE  
ADDITIONAL FORD E-TRANSIT T-350 CARGO VAN IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO  
EXCEED \$57,516.85**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Elk Grove's Fleet Services maintains all City vehicles and procures replacements and additional vehicles when necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, one additional vehicle is needed to accommodate the Public Works Department's new Fleet Supervisor position in Fiscal Year 2025-26; and

**WHEREAS**, current economic conditions, including supply chain and manufacturing delays are creating long lead times for the order and receipt of new vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of California opened a competitive bidding process for the purchase of Ford e-Transit T-350 Cargo Vans in 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, 72 Hour LLC, dba Watsonville Fleet Group was awarded the State of California's large quantity contract for Ford e-Transit T-350 Cargo Vans, which was competitively bid and Watsonville Fleet Group will honor such state-contract pricing in sales of vehicles to the City; thus, the City is receiving a competitive price and the expenditures of staff time to compile the necessary bid documents a second time will not likely result in a better price or an outcome more advantageous to the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

1. Finds that a formal bidding procedure is not in the best interest of the City and dispenses with the formal bidding procedure for the subject vehicles pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.180(B)(3) and authorizes the purchase of the subject vehicles pursuant to the terms and conditions of the competitively-bid State of California Contract #1-22-23-23E; and
2. Authorizes the City Manager to execute a contract with 72 Hour LLC, dba Watsonville Fleet Group, a California corporation, in substantially the form presented, for the purchase of one additional Ford e-Transit T-350 Cargo Van in an amount not to exceed \$57,516.85.
