

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-075

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING THE FY2025 THERMOPLASTIC RESTRIPING PROJECT (MP2503); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH CENTRAL STRIPING SERVICE, INC. FOR THE FY2025 THERMOPLASTIC RESTRIPING PROJECT (MP2503) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$147,505.70; AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS NOT-TO-EXCEED \$22,125.00; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH THE SECOND LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER IF THE FIRST LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER DOES NOT MEET FILING OBLIGATIONS (CEQA EXEMPT)

WHEREAS, the FY2025 Thermoplastic Restriping Project (MP2503) (Project) includes restriping various streets throughout the City of Elk Grove with thermoplastic spray material; and

WHEREAS, an invitation to bid was duly advertised on March 21, 2025 and March 28, 2025, and electronic bids were received on April 17, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Central Striping Service, Inc. was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, WGJ Enterprises Inc. DBA PCI was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the second lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, the Project is a project under California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000 et seq. of the Public Resources Code, hereinafter referred to as CEQA) which requires that cities consider the environmental consequences of their actions before approving a project; and

WHEREAS, the Project is included in the approved Fiscal Year 2024-25 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Finds the FY2025 Thermoplastic Restriping Project (MP2503) exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15301 (existing facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines based upon the following finding:

Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines (Chapter 3 of Division 6 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations) provides an exemption from CEQA for projects involving the minor alteration of existing public or private facilities when the alteration involves negligible or no expansion of an existing use. The Project involves restriping various streets throughout the City of Elk Grove with thermoplastic spray material. The proposed improvements would occur within existing City-owned infrastructure and would not add any additional vehicle travel lanes; therefore, the Project would result in no expansion of use and qualifies for the identified exemption. No additional environmental review under CEQA is required; and

- 2) Approves the Project; and
- 3) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Central Striping Service, Inc. for the FY2025 Thermoplastic Restriping Project (MP2503) in the amount of \$147,505.70 upon receipt of all required bonds and insurance and the approval of such bonds and insurance by the City Attorney; and
- 4) Authorizes the Public Works Director to approve change orders not-to-exceed \$22,125.00; and
- 5) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with the second lowest responsive bidder, WGJ Enterprises, Inc. DBA PCI, if, Central Striping Service, Inc., does not meet filing obligations.


