

## RESOLUTION NO. 2025-114

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE ESTABLISHING FOUR-YEAR TERMS OF SERVICE FOR APPOINTMENTS TO ALL CITY BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, AND COMMITTEES, AND ADOPTING AN INITIAL SCHEDULE FOR BIENNIAL TERM EXPIRATIONS

**WHEREAS**, on February 20, 2025, a special meeting was held for the City Council Retreat, and during General Governance discussions, the City Council provided direction to return an item for consideration of implementing four-year terms for appointees to all City boards, commissions, and committees, with no maximum term limits, and establishing a staggered term expiration of all appointments on a biennial basis; and

**WHEREAS**, with the introduction of Ordinance No. 15-2025 on June 11, 2025, Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 1.03.040 will establish that terms of service for all appointments to City boards, commissions, and committees shall be set by resolution of the City Council, that there shall be no maximum number of terms that any appointee may serve, and that appointments to City boards, committees, and commissions shall have biennial term expirations with a Schedule of Term Expirations for individual seats to be established by resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, this resolution shall set the length of appointment terms of service and establish the process for creating the initial Schedule of Term Expirations for all appointments.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Elk Grove as follows:

Section 1. Subject to the provision of this resolution, and any other applicable law, the term of service shall be four years for each appointee for all City boards, commissions, and committees. There shall be no maximum number of terms that an appointee may serve on any City board, commission, or committee. Current appointees to any City board, commission, and committee may continue to serve, subject to removal by the City Council or resignation of the appointee, until the commencement of the "Initial Term" as set forth at Exhibit A, attached hereto. Any new appointee to any City board, commission, and committee appointed before the "Initial Term," as set forth at Exhibit A, may also continue to serve, subject to removal by the City Council or resignation of the appointee, until the commencement of the "Initial Term" as set forth at Exhibit A.

Section 2. The biennial (every two years) term expirations of appointments shall follow the Schedule of Term Expirations attached hereto as Exhibit A, which establishes the division of the seats (designated by seat number) on each City board, commission, or committee. The Initial Term provides for staggered terms to help maintain continuity by preserving historical knowledge possessed by appointees to City boards, commissions, and committees, with some seats having less than a four-year Initial Term.

Section 3. Except as set forth herein, the appointees in the longest tenured seats on each City board, commission, and committee shall have term expirations in February 2027. Notwithstanding the foregoing, in those cases where appointees have the same appointment date to a particular City board, commission, or committee, earlier term

expiration dates and commencement of new terms for less than all appointees of the City board, commission, or committees shall be determined alphabetically based on the last name of the current appointee, commencing in 2027, all as set forth at Exhibit A. For those boards, commissions, and committees with an odd number of seats, the majority of seats for current appointees shall have a term expiration in 2027, with the remaining term of current appointees expiring in 2029, all as set forth at Exhibit A. Thereafter, term expirations of appointments shall occur in February of odd numbered years starting in 2031, with a portion of the seats having term expirations each cycle in alternating fashion. All terms following the Initial Term shall be for four years.

Section 4. Appointees whose seats are scheduled for term expiration retain the opportunity to re-apply for another four-year term. There shall be no maximum number of terms an appointee may serve.

Section 5. Subsequent vacancies of a seat following the passage of this resolution do not re-set the schedule for term expirations of that seat. The Schedule of Term Expirations is established by the initial actions set forth in Section 3 of this resolution. An appointee's term expires on the expiration of the term for that seat, regardless of the appointee's date of appointment.


Section 6. This resolution shall take effect from and after the effective date of Ordinance No. 15-2025.

*Qualifications: At time of appointment each member shall be: 1) no less than thirteen (13) years of age and no more than eighteen (18) years of age; 2) a student in grades seven (7) through twelve (12), in an approved education program for middle school or high school students; and 3) a resident of the City or its sphere of influence, at the time of application for appointment and continuously thereafter. The sphere of influence is defined to include circumstances where a member attends an Elk Grove school but lives just outside the city limits. Immediate family members of City Council Members shall not be eligible for appointment. Note that, given the nature of the Youth Commission, appointees may be rendered disqualified to serve (e.g. by age) prior to the expiration of a four-year term.*


