

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-122

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL PROCEDURE PURSUANT TO ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.188(B)(3) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH D-TAC K9 LLC, FOR POLICE CANINE TRAINING SERVICES, MODIFYING THE SCOPE OF WORK, LIST OF SERVICES, AND PRICING, AND INCREASING TOTAL COMPENSATION BY \$150,000 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2028 [FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$402,000]

WHEREAS, the Elk Grove Police Department (EGPD) has a Canine Unit made up of six police canines and their police officer handlers; and

WHEREAS, the Canine Unit assists with criminal apprehension, narcotics and firearms detection, locating missing persons, and providing public demonstrations; and

WHEREAS, this type of work requires on-going professional training provided by individuals with extensive police canine expertise; and

WHEREAS, in 2019, staff publicly announced a Request for Proposals (RFP) seeking service providers of police canine training services and received one proposal from D-TAC K9 LLC (D-TAC K9); and

WHEREAS, staff determined D-TAC K9 was able to provide the services outlined in the RFP and the City Council authorized the execution of a contract for services with D-TAC K9 for a three-year term with an optional three-year extension at the City's sole discretion; and

WHEREAS, in 2022, due to exceptional training services provided by D-TAC K9, the City Council approved the first amendment to the contract, extending the term an additional three years; and

WHEREAS, the EGPD Canine Unit has continued to receive superior, dependable training from D-TAC K9 for the past six years; and

WHEREAS, the first amendment to the contract with D-TAC K9 expires June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, for the reasons presented, a formal request for proposal procedure is not in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby dispenses with the formal request for proposal procedure pursuant to EGMC Section 3.42.188(B)(3) and authorizes the City Manager to:

1. Execute the second amendment to the contract with D-TAC K9 LLC for police canine training, in substantially the form presented, modifying the scope of work, list of services, and pricing, and increasing total compensation by \$150,000 through June 30, 2028 [*for a total contract amount not to exceed \$402,000*]; and

2. Execute all future amendments to the agreement concerning extensions of time and increases to pricing for services as allowed by the contract, subject to budget approval.
