

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-126

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
DECLARING NO MAJORITY PROTEST AND SETTING RESIDENTIAL SOLID
WASTE SERVICE RATES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-26**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Franchise Agreement for Solid Waste Collection Services between the City of Elk Grove (City) and Allied Waste Services of North America, LLC (d.b.a. "Republic Services"), Republic Services is entitled to an annual compensation adjustment to cover inflationary increases in the cost to provide these services; and

WHEREAS, Article XIID, Section 6 of the California Constitution, added by the voters with the passage of Proposition 218 in 1996, contains procedural requirements that must be met whenever a property-related fee is imposed or increased; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove has an obligation to notify all affected property owners and ratepayers of an increase in the rates owed to Republic Services; and

WHEREAS, during the last week of April as well as the first week of May 2025, staff prepared and mailed two notices to all 55,249 solid waste service customers and all residential property owners notifying them of the proposed rate increase and the public hearings to be held on June 11 and June 25, 2025; and

WHEREAS, in order for a majority protest to exist, written protests received by the City must exceed 50% of the impacted parcels (i.e. 50% plus one); and

WHEREAS, the City has not received sufficient written protests to constitute a majority protest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby finds that no majority protest has been received for the proposed rate increase and sets the Solid Waste Service Rates for FY 2025-26 as shown in the attached Exhibit A incorporated herein by reference, with an effective date of July 1, 2025.
