

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-139

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCEDURE PURSUANT TO ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.180(B)(3) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SIXTH AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH GALLS, LLC (CONTRACT NO. C-17-297) FOR BALLISTIC VEST SYSTEMS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$225,000, FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$720,000 THROUGH JULY 31, 2028

WHEREAS, each sworn and non-sworn field officer of the Elk Grove Police Department (EGPD) is issued a ballistic vest system, which is used to protect field personnel and is worn at all times when on duty; and

WHEREAS, EGPD exclusively procures ballistic vest systems manufactured by Point Blank Enterprises, Inc. (Point Blank), based on exceptional durability and to maintain interchangeability of components and minimize replacement costs; and

WHEREAS, in 2017, pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.180(A), staff conducted a formal bidding procedure seeking qualified vendors to provide competitively priced ballistic vest systems, and awarded a contract to Galls, LLC (Galls), a local, authorized seller of Point Blank ballistic vest systems; and

WHEREAS, in 2018, the City entered into the first amendment to the contract with Galls to increase the contract's not-to-exceed amount to accommodate additional purchases, without changing the contract term; and

WHEREAS, in 2019 and 2022, the City entered into the second and third amendments to the contract with Galls, to extend the contract term and maintain access to competitively priced ballistic vest systems; and

WHEREAS, in 2023 and 2024, the City entered into the fourth and fifth amendments to the contract with Galls to adjust individual item pricing to reflect manufacturer cost increases without impacting the overall not-to-exceed amount; and

WHEREAS, the current contract with Galls is set to expire on July 31, 2025, and Galls has agreed to continue to offer EGPD the same products and competitive pricing under the terms and conditions set forth in the 2017 contract, as amended; and

WHEREAS, for the reasons presented, pursuing a formal bidding procedure for the purchase of ballistic vest systems is not in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby dispenses with the formal bidding procedure pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.180(B)(3) and authorizes the City Manager to:

1. Execute the Sixth Amendment to Contract #C-17-297 with Galls, LLC for ballistic vest systems, in substantially the form presented, updating the product list, extending the term of the contract through July 31, 2028, and increasing the total compensation by \$225,000, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$720,000.

2. Execute all future amendments to the Contract concerning extensions of time and increases to product pricing as allowed by the Contract, provided that such amendments do not result in an increase to the total compensation paid to Galls.
