

**RESOLUTION NO. 2025-156**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING THE BRIDGE PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE PROJECT (WBR004); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH AMERICAN CIVIL CONSTRUCTORS WEST COAST LLC FOR THE PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$485,000; AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS NOT-TO-EXCEED \$72,750; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH THE SECOND LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER IF THE FIRST LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER DOES NOT MEET FILING OBLIGATIONS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A COST SHARING AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO FOR PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE ON WILTON ROAD BRIDGE OVER DEER CREEK; AND AMENDING THE FY 2025-26 BUDGET AND 2025-2030 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM IN FUND 338, EXTERNAL AGENCY FUNDS AND FUND 294, MEASURE A FUNDS (CEQA EXEMPT)**

**WHEREAS**, the Bridge Preventative Maintenance Project (WBR004) (Project) includes replacing bridge deck joint seals and treating concrete bridge deck with high molecular weight methacrylate (HMWM) resin (Work); and

**WHEREAS**, an invitation to bid was duly advertised on May 23, 2025 and May 30, 2025, and electronic bids were received on June 19, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, American Civil Constructors West Coast LLC was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid; and

**WHEREAS**, Dees Burke Engineering was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the second lowest responsive bid; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project is a project under California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000 et seq. of the Public Resources Code, hereinafter referred to as CEQA) which requires that cities consider the environmental consequences of their actions before approving a project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project is included in the approved Fiscal Year 2025-30 Capital Improvement Program and is budgeted with funds in the approved Fiscal Year 2025-26 Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the City and County share ownership of a portion of Wilton Road bridge over Deer Creek (Bridge No. 24C0079), located 4,800 feet southeast of the intersection of Wilton Road and Grant Line Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Elk Grove developed the Project and will manage improvements of the joint bridge facility as part of the Bridge Preventative Maintenance Project (WBR004) and the City of Elk Grove prepared the plans and specifications necessary to bid the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Elk Grove will award the construction contract and manage the construction of the improvements, and the County of Sacramento will

reimburse the City of Elk Grove for the County's share of the construction engineering and construction costs, up to a limit of \$135,000.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Finds the Bridge Preventative Maintenance Project (WBR004) exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15301 (existing facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines based upon the following finding:

Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines (Chapter 3 of Division 6 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations) provides an exemption from CEQA for projects involving the minor alteration of existing public or private facilities when the alteration involves negligible or no expansion of an existing use. This Project involves replacing bridge deck joint seals and treating concrete bridge deck with high molecular weight methacrylate resin. The proposed improvements would occur within existing City/County-owned infrastructure and would not add any additional vehicle travel lanes. Further, the existing bridge was reconstructed in 1993 and does not meet the age requirements for significance evaluation on the California Register of Historical Resources. As the bridge is not historic and as the proposed improvements would result in no expansion of use, the Project qualifies for the identified exemption. No additional environmental review under CEQA is required; and

- 2) Approves the Project; and
- 3) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with American Civil Constructors West Coast LLC for the Bridge Preventative Maintenance Project (WBR004) in the amount of \$485,000 upon receipt of all required bonds and insurance and the approval of such bonds and insurance by the City Attorney; and,
- 4) Authorizes the Public Works Director to approve change orders not-to-exceed \$72,750; and,
- 5) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with the second lowest responsive bidder, Dees Burke Engineering, if, American Civil Constructors West Coast LLC, does not meet filing obligations;
- 6) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a cost sharing agreement with the County of Sacramento for preventative maintenance on Wilton Road bridge over Deer Creek; and
- 7) Amends the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Budget and 2025-2030 Capital Improvement Program by adding \$135,000 in External Agency Funds (Fund 338) and returning \$291,410.25 to fund balance for WBR004 in Measure A Funds (Fund 294).


