

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-158

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCEDURE PURSUANT TO ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.180(B)(4) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH NATIONAL AUTO FLEET GROUP, A CALIFORNIA CORPORATION, FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 2026 FORD SUPER DUTY F-450 ROADLINE STENCIL TRUCK IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$157,344.39, OR OTHER SUCH AMOUNT AS MAY BE DIRECTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove's Fleet section maintains all existing City vehicles and procures additional vehicles when necessary; and

WHEREAS, as part of the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Budget, City Council approved an additional Maintenance Technician position with the Public Works Operations and Maintenance Division; and

WHEREAS, the Maintenance Technician will ensure that traffic lanes, crosswalks, stop lines, arrows, and other essential road markings are clearly visible and meet safety standards; and

WHEREAS, to perform these duties, the Maintenance Technician requires a stencil truck to carry the necessary tools, parts, supplies, and equipment; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell is a public agency that offers competitively solicited purchasing contracts for products and equipment to member agencies, including the City, by issuing Request for Proposals (RFPs) for national distribution, streamlining procurement and ensuring competitive solicitations that typically meet or exceed local requirements; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell received bids for automobiles, suvs, vans and light trucks with related equipment and accessories, and National Auto Fleet Group was selected by Sourcewell and was issued Contract #091521-NAF; and

WHEREAS, National Auto Fleet Group can readily serve Sourcewell's participating entities with the capability to build and price vehicles conveniently and offer competitive discounts from MSRP; and

WHEREAS, for the reasons presented, pursuing a formal bidding process for the purchase of the subject stencil truck is not in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Operations and Maintenance Division budget has sufficient funding identified in the Fiscal Year 2025-26 operating budget for this purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Determines that a formal bidding procedure is not in the best interest of the City for the subject stencil truck and hereby dispenses with the formal bidding requirements pursuant to the Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.180(B)(4) for a contract for the purchase of the subject equipment; and
- 2) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a contract with National Auto Fleet Group, a California Corporation, for the purchase of a 2026 Ford Super Duty F-450 Roadline Stencil Truck in an amount not-to-exceed \$157,344.39.
