

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-175

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING THE RECTANGULAR RAPID FLASHING BEACON CROSSINGS AT FOUR ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS PROJECT (WAM038); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH ZARA CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$158,932; AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS NOT TO EXCEED \$1,589; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH THE SECOND LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER IF THE FIRST LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER DOES NOT MEET FILING OBLIGATIONS; AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-26 BUDGET AND 2025-2030 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BUDGET BY \$2,480 (CEQA EXEMPT)

WHEREAS, the Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon Crossings at Four Elementary Schools (WAM038) (Project) includes installation of Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) crossings at uncontrolled crossings leading to Foulks Ranch Elementary School, Franklin Elementary School, Helen Carr Castello Elementary School, and Roy Herburger Elementary School (Work); and

WHEREAS, an invitation to bid was duly advertised on July 25, 2025, and August 1, 2025, and electronic bids were received on August 26, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Zara Construction, Inc. was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, Tim Paxin's Pacific Excavation dba Pacific Excavation was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the second lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, the Project is a project under California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000 et seq. of the Public Resources Code, hereinafter referred to as CEQA) which requires that cities consider the environmental consequences of their actions before approving a project; and

WHEREAS, the Project is included in the approved 2025-2030 Capital Improvement Program and is budgeted with funds in the approved Fiscal Year 2025-26 Budget; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Finds the Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon Crossings at Four Elementary Schools Project (WAM038) exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15301 (existing facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines based upon the following finding:

Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines (Chapter 3 of Division 6 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations) provides an exemption from CEQA for projects involving the minor alteration of existing public or private facilities when the alteration involves negligible or no

expansion of an existing use. The Project involves installation of Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon crossings at uncontrolled crossings leading to Foulks Ranch Elementary School, Franklin Elementary School, Helen Carr Castello Elementary School, and Roy Herburger Elementary School. The proposed improvements would occur within existing City-owned infrastructure and would not add any additional vehicle travel lanes; therefore, the Project would result in no expansion of use and qualifies for the identified exemption. No additional environmental review under CEQA is required; and


- 2) Approves the Project; and
- 3) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Zara Construction, Inc. for the Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon Crossings at Four Elementary Schools (WAM038) in the amount of \$158,932 upon receipt of all required bonds and insurance and the approval of such bonds and insurance by the City Attorney; and,
- 4) Authorizes the Public Works Director to approve change orders not to exceed \$1,589; and,
- 5) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with the second lowest responsive bidder, Tim Paxin's Pacific Excavation dba Pacific Excavation, if, Zara Construction, Inc., does not meet filing obligations; and
- 6) Amends the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Budget and 2025-2030 Capital Improvement Program as follows:
 - a. Adds \$2,480 in State Capital Grants (Fund 302) to the WAM038 Project
