

**RESOLUTION NO. 2025-192**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE  
DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCEDURE PURSUANT TO ELK  
GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.180(B)(4) (COOPERATIVE PURCHASING  
AGREEMENT) AND AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF INFORMATION OFFICER TO  
EXECUTE ORDER FORMS AND SUCH OTHER DOCUMENTS AS MAY BE  
NECESSARY FOR THE PURCHASE OF REPLACEMENT POLICE MOBILE  
COMPUTERS AND RELATED HARDWARE FROM DELL MARKETING, L.P.  
FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$301,582.13**

**WHEREAS**, Elk Grove police officers are required to use mobile computers to support their work in the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the mobile computers currently used by officers in patrol vehicles are 5 years old and have exceeded their life expectancy; and

**WHEREAS**, replacing existing mobile computers with Dell products allows the department to utilize existing Dell hardware installed in department vehicles and maintain consistency throughout its hardware inventory; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Sections 3.42.180(B)(4) and 3.42.220, the City Council may dispense with the formal bidding procedure when the purchase is processed through a cooperative purchasing agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement #23026, and California Participating Addendum #7-23-70-55-0 has secured competitive pricing for these commodities and the City of Elk Grove may take advantage of this pricing; and

**WHEREAS**, the terms and conditions of the NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement #23036 and California Participating Addendum #7-23-70-55-0 shall apply to this transaction.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby dispenses with the formal bidding procedure pursuant to EGMC Section 3.42.180(B)(4) (Cooperative Purchasing Agreement) AND and authorizes the Chief Information Officer to execute order forms and such documents as may be necessary to implement the NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement #23036 and California Participating Addendum #7-23-70-55-0 with Dell Marketing, L.P., in substantially the form presented, for the purchase of police mobile computers and related hardware for a total amount not-to-exceed \$301,582.13.


