

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-203

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCEDURE PURSUANT TO ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.180(B)(3) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE FOURTH AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH AXON ENTERPRISE, INC. MODIFYING THE PRODUCT LIST AND PAYMENT SCHEDULE FOR THE PURCHASE OF ADDITIONAL GOODS AND SERVICES SPECIFIC TO THE CITY'S COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$142,350.06, THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2029, WITH FUTURE TASK ORDERS FOR ADDITIONAL POLICE DEPARTMENT PRODUCTS TO REMAIN AUTHORIZED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE, SUBJECT TO BUDGETARY LIMITS

WHEREAS, the City has contracted with Axon Enterprise, Inc. (Axon) since April 2022, for a technological solution that seamlessly integrates body-worn cameras, in-car cameras, tasers, and the storage of their associated digital evidence for the Elk Grove Police Department (EGPD); and

WHEREAS, upholding the safety of the community extends beyond EGPD and includes the City's Code Enforcement Division and Homeless Navigators, part of the Community Development Department (CDD), who also play vital roles in public safety through frequent field interactions with residents, businesses, and individuals experiencing homelessness; and

WHEREAS, with the success of Axon technologies at EGPD, it is ideal that CDD staff and other public-facing employees are similarly equipped to effectively and safely provide services; and

WHEREAS, CDD desires to add certain goods and services, such as those provided to EGPD by Axon, under the current Contract to enhance the safety of certain CDD staff while engaging with the community; and

WHEREAS, for the reasons presented, pursuit of the formal bidding procedure is not in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby dispenses with the formal bidding procedure pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.180(B)(3) and authorizes the City Manager to:


1. Execute the fourth amendment to the contract with Axon Enterprise, Inc., in substantially the form presented, modifying the product list and payment schedule to include certain hardware, software, technology, and training for CDD staff through the existing term ending December 31, 2029; and
2. Authorizes the Chief of Police to execute future task orders for the purchase of additional product quantities required to meet the needs of the City, provided that such task orders do not result in an increase that exceeds budgeted amounts approved by the City Council during the annual budget process.
