

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-012

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING THE GUARDRAIL REPLACEMENT ON WEST AND EAST STOCKTON BLVD. PROJECT (WTR097); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH MIDSTATE BARRIER, INC. FOR THE PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$400,098; AND AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS NOT-TO-EXCEED \$40,010 (CEQA EXEMPT)

WHEREAS, the Guardrail Replacement on West and East Stockton Blvd. Project (WTR097) (Project) includes removal of existing metal beam guard rails, installing new metal beam guard rails, end treatments, concrete barriers, and signs, and other related Work along E. Stockton Boulevard and W. Stockton Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, an invitation to bid was duly advertised on November 14, 2025 and November 21, 2025, and electronic bids were received on December 16, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Apex Fence Company's bid was found to be non-responsive; and

WHEREAS, Midstate Barrier, Inc. was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, the Project is a project under California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000 et seq. of the Public Resources Code, hereinafter referred to as CEQA) which requires that cities consider the environmental consequences of their actions before approving a project; and

WHEREAS, the Project is included in the approved 2025-2030 Capital Improvement Program and is budgeted with funds in the approved Fiscal Year 2025-26 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Finds the Guardrail Replacement on West and East Stockton Blvd. (WTR097) exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15301 (existing facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines based upon the following finding:

Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines (Chapter 3 of Division 6 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations) provides an exemption from CEQA for projects involving the minor alteration of existing public or private facilities when the alteration involves negligible or no expansion of an existing use. This Project includes removal of the existing metal beam guard rails, installing new metal beam guard rails, end treatments, concrete barriers, and signs, and other related Work along E. Stockton Boulevard and W. Stockton Boulevard. As these proposed alterations and modifications would occur to existing City-owned facilities, would negligibly expand the existing use of these facilities, would not result in additional travel lanes, and would not have a significant effect on the environment, the Project qualifies for the identified exemption. No further environmental review under CEQA is required; and


- 2) Approves the Project; and
- 3) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Midstate Barrier, Inc. for the Guardrail Replacement on West and East Stockton Blvd. Project (WTR097) in the amount of \$400,098 upon receipt of all required bonds and insurance and the approval of such bonds and insurance by the City Attorney; and,
- 4) Authorizes the Public Works Director to approve change orders not to exceed \$40,010.
