

**RESOLUTION NO. 2026-022**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE  
DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCEDURE PURSUANT TO ELK  
GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.180(B)(3); AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH  
MERRIMAC PETROLEUM INC., DBA MERRIMAC ENERGY GROUP OF LONG  
BEACH, TO PROVIDE BULK AND CARD LOCK FUEL SERVICES FOR CITY  
OWNED VEHICLES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$930,000, FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT  
AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$3,430,000; AND AMENDING  
THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-26 BUDGET**

**WHEREAS**, fueling City owned vehicles is necessary to delivering service to the residents of Elk Grove; and

**WHEREAS**, in June 2022, the City conducted an invitation to bid (ITB) to seek economies of scale and thereby complied with the formal bidding requirements found in Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.180(a); and

**WHEREAS**, Merrimac Petroleum Inc., dba Merrimac Energy Group, met all of the requirements of the ITB, and was therefore found to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

**WHEREAS**, In June 2025, a First Amendment to the contract was executed with the option to extend the contract term for an additional two years, terminating on July 14, 2027; and

**WHEREAS**, increasing the current contract amount by an additional \$930,000 is necessary to continue services with Merrimac Petroleum Inc., through the end of the current contract term (July 14, 2027); and

**WHEREAS**, pursuing a formal bidding process for the subject additional fueling services may cause operational delays, compliance and risk exposure, and interrupt fueling service needs for all City vehicles and equipment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby


1. Finds that a formal bidding procedure is not in the best interest of the City for the additional fueling costs and dispenses with the formal bidding procedure pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.180(B)(3); and
2. Authorizes the City Manager to execute the second amendment to the contract with Merrimac Petroleum Inc., dba Merrimac Energy Group, in substantially the form presented, to continue to provide fueling services, in the amount of \$930,000 for a total contract amount not to exceed \$3,430,000; and
3. Amends the FY 2025-26 Budget to authorize the addition of \$65,000 to Fund 602 for the cost of these services through June 30, 2026.
