**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-26 BUDGET IN ACCORDANCE WITH A
CREDIT REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT WITH POPPY GROVE DEVELOPERS,
LLC, FOR PRIVATELY CONSTRUCTED FACILITIES IN THE CITY OF CITY OF ELK
GROVE ROADWAY FEE PROGRAM FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE POPPY GROVE
APARTMENTS PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the City has established various development impact fee programs to facilitate fair-share financing for the cost of public facilities necessitated by new development projects and has set forth guidelines for the programs in Elk Grove Municipal Code (EGMC) Chapter 16.95, and the City of Elk Grove Roadway Fee Program (Roadway Program) is one such program; and

WHEREAS, if developers advance the construction of eligible facilities as a condition of development, they may seek reimbursement for the cost of the improvements, typically in the form of fee credits, subject to certain limitations defined in the Drainage and Roadway Programs; and

WHEREAS, City Council has previously approved Credit Reimbursement Agreement C-25-443 (Agreement) with Poppy Grove Developers, LLC (the Developer), relative to roadway improvements included in the Roadway Program; and

WHEREAS, consistent with EGMC Chapter 16.95, the Developer may request reimbursement by way of fee credits or, if all conditions are met, cash reimbursement from the Roadway Program for the improvements according to the requirements and limitations defined in the Roadway Program, and whereas the Developer has met these certain conditions for a credit or cash reimbursement and has requested or is in the process of requesting such from the Roadway Program, which necessitates a budget adjustment to the Roadway Program fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby amends the Fiscal Year 2025-26 budget in accordance with a credit reimbursement agreement with Poppy Grove Developers, LLC, for privately constructed facilities in the City of Elk Grove Roadway Fee Program for the benefit of the Poppy Grove Apartments Project, and that there is sufficient funding within Roadway Program Fund 328 to account for the entirety of the Agreement between the City and the Developer, net of any credits used and credits previously reimbursed, and that the amount in the Agreement is the maximum reimbursement amount and shall not be exceeded as follows:




