**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS TO THE
CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES RECYCLING AND RECOVERY
(CALRECYCLE) FOR EVERY TWO-YEAR GRANT CYCLE FOR THE LOCAL
GOVERNMENT WASTE TIRE AMNESTY GRANT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code section 40000, et seq. authorizes the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), to administer various grant programs (grants) in furtherance of the State of California's (state) efforts to reduce, recycle, and reuse solid waste generated in the state, thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority, CalRecycle is required to establish necessary procedures governing the application, award and management of its grants; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle grant application procedures require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove (City) will function as an individual applicant or as a regional lead jurisdiction partner by acting on behalf of the cities of Sacramento, Rancho Cordova, Galt, Citrus Heights, and the unincorporated areas of Sacramento County, thus allowing residents of those jurisdictions to utilize the Special Waste Collection Center (SWCC) as a collection site for waste tires; and

WHEREAS, by applying for the CalRecycle Tire Amnesty Grant for every two-year grant cycle, the City is seeking funding for the costs to collect, process, and recycle tires from the residents of Elk Grove, the unincorporated areas of Sacramento County, and the cities of Sacramento, Galt, Citrus Heights, and Rancho Cordova.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Authorizes the City Manager to submit a Local Government Waste Tire Amnesty regional grant application on behalf of the City of Elk Grove and, acting as Regional Lead Jurisdiction partner, on behalf of the cities of Sacramento, Rancho Cordova, Galt, Citrus Heights, and the unincorporated areas of Sacramento County for the collection of used tires; and
- 2) Authorizes the City Manager to execute on behalf of the City of Elk Grove all grant-related documents, including, but not limited to: Applications, Payment Requests, Agreements, and Amendments necessary to secure Grant funds and to implement the approved grant project; and
- 3) Authorizes the submittal of applications to CalRecycle for the Tire Amnesty Grant until rescinded or amended by the City Council of the City of Elk Grove.


