

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-038

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS FOR SERVICE WITH CONTINENTAL COLLISION, CALIBER COLLISION, AND DOWNTOWN FORD SALES FOR CITY VEHICLE BODY REPAIR AND PAINTING SERVICES FOR AN INITIAL TERM OF THREE YEARS WITH TWO OPTIONAL ONE-YEAR EXTENSIONS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THE AMOUNT BUDGETED FOR THIS WORK IN THE ADOPTED FISCAL YEAR BUDGET FOR EACH YEAR OF THE CONTRACT TERM; AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO APPROVE WRITTEN REQUESTS FOR ADJUSTMENTS TO PRICING BASED ON DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES CALIFORNIA CONSTRUCTION COST INDEX (CCCI) INCREASES AFTER THE INITIAL THREE YEAR TERM; AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-26 BUDGET

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove (City) operates a vehicle fleet primarily used by the Police, Animal Services, Public Works, and Code Enforcement departments; and

WHEREAS, to ensure the fleet remains operational and safe, vehicle body repair and painting services are needed; and

WHEREAS, the City's previous vehicle auto body and painting contract with Continental Collision (C-20-717) expired on November 18, 2025; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the City's purchasing ordinance, staff prepared and advertised a Request for Proposals (RFP) for Vehicle Body Repair and Painting Services for City vehicles and received three proposals on December 16, 2025; and

WHEREAS, after review of the three proposals, Continental Collision, Caliber Collision, and Downtown Ford Sales were determined to be qualified service providers; and

WHEREAS, having a contract with Continental Collision, Caliber Collision, and Downtown Ford Sales will ensure operational efficiency, minimize vehicle downtime, and avoid service delays that might occur if one provider is unavailable; and

WHEREAS, increasing the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Budget amount by an additional \$100,000 is necessary to resume auto body and painting services through the end of the fiscal year (June 30, 2026). Funding for future years will be included in the respective fiscal year budgets for the term of the contracts subject to City Council approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Authorizes the City Manager to execute Contracts for Service with Continental Collision, Caliber Collision, and Downtown Ford Sales, in substantially the forms presented, for City vehicle auto body repair and painting services with an initial term of three years with two optional one-year extensions and in an amount not to exceed the amount budgeted for this work in the respective fiscal year budgets for each year of the contract term;


- 2) Authorizes the Public Works Director to approve written requests for adjustments to the rates set forth in the contract/agreement to reflect any Department of General Services California Construction Cost Index (CCCI) increases after the initial three-year term, subject to approval of annual budgets by the City Council; and
- 3) Amends the FY 2025-26 Budget to authorize the addition of \$100,000 to Fund 602 for the cost of these services through June 30, 2026. There are sufficient funds in Fund 602 fund balance to support this amendment.


