

**RESOLUTION NO. 2026-056**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING THE CLASS II BIKE LANE INSTALLATION ON VARIOUS STREETS PROJECT (WAM039); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH CHRISP COMPANY FOR THE PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$145,010; AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS NOT TO EXCEED \$29,000; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH THE SECOND LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER IF THE FIRST LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER DOES NOT MEET FILING OBLIGATIONS (CEQA EXEMPT)**

**WHEREAS**, the Class II Bike Lane Installation on Various Streets Project (WAM039) (Project) includes installation of Class II bike lanes at seven locations Citywide, including striping, markings and signs; and

**WHEREAS**, an invitation to bid was duly advertised on January 30, 2026, and February 6, 2026, and electronic bids were received on Tuesday, March 10, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, Chrisp Company was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid; and

**WHEREAS**, Centerline Striping, Inc. was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the second lowest responsive bid; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project is a project under California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000 et seq. of the Public Resources Code, hereinafter referred to as CEQA) which requires that cities consider the environmental consequences of their actions before approving a project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project is included in the approved 2025-2030 Capital Improvement Program and is budgeted with funds in the approved Fiscal Year 2025-26 Budget.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Finds the Class II Bike Lane Installation on Various Streets Project (WAM039) exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15301 (existing facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines based upon the following finding:

Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines (Chapter 3 of Division 6 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations) provides an exemption from CEQA for projects involving the minor alteration of existing public or private facilities when the alteration involves negligible or no expansion of an existing use. This Project involves installation of Class II bike lanes within existing roadways, including striping, markings and signs. The proposed improvements would occur within existing City-owned infrastructure and would not add any additional vehicle travel lanes; therefore, the Project would result in no expansion of use and qualifies for the identified exemption. No additional environmental review under CEQA is required; and

- 2) Approves the Project; and


- 3) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Crisp Company for the Class II Bike Lane Installation on Various Streets Project (WAM039) in the amount of \$145,010 upon receipt of all required bonds and insurance and the approval of such bonds and insurance by the City Attorney; and
- 4) Authorizes the Public Works Director to approve change orders not to exceed \$29,000; and,
- 5) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with the second lowest responsive bidder, Centerline Striping, Inc., if Crisp Company does not meet filing obligations.


