

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-073

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE SUPPORTING THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING AND SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITIES (AHSC) PROGRAM APPLICATION FOR THE POWER INN ROAD SAFETY AND CONGESTION RELIEF PROJECT (WTR100) AND PROPOSED NEW STRAWBERRY CREEK TRAIL PROJECT (WTL044) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS IN SUPPORT OF THE APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the California Strategic Growth Council administers the Affordable Housing and Sustainable Communities (AHSC) Program to fund projects that integrate affordable housing and transportation improvements that reduce greenhouse gas emissions and improve mobility; and

WHEREAS, Resources for Community Development (RCD) is preparing an AHSC grant application to improve bicycle and pedestrian access surrounding 8370 Power Inn Road development area which aligns with the City's Power Inn Road Safety and Congestion Relief Project (WTR100) and proposed new Strawberry Creek Trail Project (WTL044) (Projects); and

WHEREAS, the AHSC application includes proposed Sustainable Transportation Infrastructure (STI) improvements consisting of bicycle, pedestrian, and related multimodal improvements, including but not limited to:

STI #1: Power Inn Road Safety and Congestion Relief Project (WTR100): The project will complete pavement resurfacing, green bike lane markings, new bike lane buffer, ADA curb ramp upgrades, and a traffic signal installation (at Power Inn Rd. and Geneva Pointe Dr.). This will add additional scope of work to the project which includes: upgrading the bike lane to a class IV facility with concrete curb barriers and reflective delineators for a total distance of 2.6 miles, a signalized pedestrian crossing to connect two trail segments, and upgrade a total of 59 curb ramps.

STI #2: Strawberry Creek Trail Project (WTL044): the proposed project will construct approximately 4,000 feet of new Class I multi use trail, providing a continuous paved connection for bicyclists and pedestrians. The trail will include appropriate amenities and will improve access to nearby schools, neighborhoods, and existing trail systems.; and

WHEREAS, the proposed STI improvements are located within public right-of-way owned and controlled by the City of Elk Grove, and the City has site control for the purposes of the AHSC application; and

WHEREAS, the proposed improvements are consistent with the City's General Plan, transportation policies, and goals related to safety, mobility, and sustainability; and

WHEREAS, the City is a partner in the AHSC application and, if awarded, would be responsible for implementing the STI improvements; and

WHEREAS, submission of a letter of support and related documentation is required as part of the AHSC application; and

WHEREAS, providing support for the application does not obligate the City to accept grant funding or commit financial resources at this time, and any such commitments will be subject to future City Council approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to provide a letter of support and commitment for the Affordable Housing and Sustainable Communities (AHSC) Program for Sustainable Transportation Infrastructure (STI) application submitted by Resources for Community Development (RCD) for the Power Inn Road Safety and Congestion Relief Project (WTR100) and proposed new Strawberry Creek Trail Project (WTL044); and
- 2) Authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to execute any documents necessary to support the application; and
- 3) Confirms the City's intent to consider future actions, if the grant is awarded, to enter into agreements and implement the proposed Sustainable Transportation Infrastructure (STI) improvements.
