**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS WITH
MUNICIPAL MAINTENANCE EQUIPMENT, INC, AND UPTIME FLEET SERVICES
DBA SUPERIOR EQUIPMENT REPAIR, INC., FOR THE INSPECTION,
MAINTENANCE, REPAIR, AND PARTS FOR CITY-OWNED HEAVY EQUIPMENT
VEHICLES FOR AN INITIAL TERM OF THREE YEARS WITH TWO OPTIONAL ONE-
YEAR EXTENSIONS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THE AMOUNT BUDGETED
FOR THIS WORK IN THE ADOPTED FISCAL YEAR BUDGET FOR EACH YEAR OF
THE CONTRACT TERM**

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove (City) maintains a heavy duty vehicle fleet consisting of street sweepers, and storm drainage and sewer trucks requiring ongoing inspections to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements and state law and routine preventative maintenance checks; and

WHEREAS, the City's current Inspection, Maintenance, Repair, and Parts for City-owned heavy equipment vehicle contract with Municipal Maintenance Equipment Inc. (C-23-216) expires on April 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the City's purchasing ordinance, staff prepared and advertised a Request for Proposals (RFP) for Inspection, Maintenance, Repair, and Parts for City-owned heavy equipment vehicle services and received two proposals on February 26, 2026; and

WHEREAS, after review of both proposals, Municipal Maintenance Equipment Inc. and Uptime Fleet Services, dba Superior Equipment Repair, Inc. were determined to be qualified service providers; and

WHEREAS, having a contract with Municipal Maintenance Equipment Inc. and Uptime Fleet Services, dba Superior Equipment Repair, Inc. will ensure operational efficiency, minimize vehicle downtime, and avoid service delays that might occur if one provider is unavailable; and

WHEREAS, Fleet Services has sufficient funding identified in its FY 2025-26 operating budget for these services. Funding for future years will be included in the respective fiscal year budgets for the term of the contracts subject to City Council approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute Contracts for Service with Municipal Maintenance Equipment Inc. and Uptime Fleet Services, dba Superior Equipment Repair, Inc., in substantially the forms presented, for inspection, maintenance, repair, and parts for City-owned heavy equipment vehicle services with an initial term of three years with two optional one-year extensions and in an amount not to exceed the amount budgeted for this work in the respective fiscal year budgets for each year of the contract term.




