**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCEDURE PURSUANT TO ELK
GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.180(B)(3) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY
MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH CAPPO MANAGEMENT XXXIV INC.,
A CALIFORNIA CORPORATION, DBA FREEWAY TOYOTA OF HANFORD, FOR
THE PURCHASE OF ONE REPLACEMENT TOYOTA PRIUS LE AND THREE NEW
TOYOTA CAMRY HYBRID LE SEDANS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
\$126,913.85**

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove's Fleet Services Division maintains all City vehicles and procures replacements and additional vehicles when necessary; and

WHEREAS, the City's Fleet Services Division has identified one Police Department vehicle that will have reached the end of its useful life of City service in Fiscal Year (FY) 2026-27 and shall be replaced with a 2026 Toyota Prius LE sedan; and

WHEREAS, the City's Police Department has identified funding to purchase three additional vehicles and shall be fulfilled with 2026 Toyota Camry Hybrid LE sedans; and

WHEREAS, current economic conditions, including ongoing supply chain and manufacturing delays are creating long lead times for the order and receipt of new vehicles; and

WHEREAS, to mitigate these delays and ensure the Police Department has safe and reliable vehicles to serve the community, staff is recommending the purchase of the one vehicle due for replacement and three additional vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the State of California opened a competitive bidding process for the purchase of Toyota Camry Hybrid LE and Toyota Prius LE sedans in 2022; and

WHEREAS, Freeway Toyota of Hanford was awarded the State of California's large quantity contract for Toyota Camry Hybrid LE and Toyota Prius LE Sedans, which was competitively bid and Freeway Toyota of Hanford will honor such state contract pricing in sales of vehicles to the City; thus, the City is receiving a competitive price and the expenditures of staff time and money to compile the necessary bid documents a second time for a small number of vehicles will not likely result in a better price or an outcome more advantageous to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

1. Dispenses with the formal bidding procedures for the subject vehicles pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.180(B)(3) and authorizes the purchase of the subject vehicles pursuant to the terms and conditions of the competitively-bid State of California Contract #1-22-23-10C; and
2. Authorizes the City Manager to execute a contract with Cappo Management XXXIV Inc., a California corporation, dba Freeway Toyota of Hanford, in substantially the form presented, for the purchase of one replacement Toyota Prius LE and three additional Toyota Camry Hybrid LE sedans in an amount not to exceed \$126,913.85.
