

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-099

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE RESCINDING AND REPLACING RESOLUTION NO. 2021-154 CONCERNING THE CONDUCT OF CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS AND THE RULES OF PROCEDURE RELATED THERETO

WHEREAS, on January 27, 2010, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove adopted Resolution No. 2010-24 concerning the rules of conduct of City Council meetings, and adopted Rules of Procedure; and

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2021, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove adopted Resolution No. 2021-154 amending the rules of conduct of City Council meetings, and adopted Rules of Procedure; and

WHEREAS, the Rules of Procedure may be amended by action of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby rescinds and replaces Resolution No. 2021-154 concerning the conduct of City Council meetings and the Rules of Procedure as follows:

1. Meetings

a. All meetings of the City Council shall be open and public, and all persons shall be permitted to attend any meeting of the City Council, except that closed sessions may be held when permitted by law.

b. The time and place of regular meetings of the City Council shall be fixed by resolution as may be amended from time to time.

c. The time, place and manner of calling special and emergency meetings and adjourning or continuing regular meetings shall be in accordance with the Ralph M. Brown Act (Government Code § 54950, et seq.).

2. Presiding Officer

a. The Mayor shall be the presiding officer. In the absence of the Mayor, the Vice Mayor shall be the presiding officer.

b. The presiding officer shall preserve order and decorum, and shall decide questions of order subject to an appeal to the City Council by any member.

3. Order of Business

a. The order of business of the City Council shall be as follows:

(1) Call to order by presiding officer;

(1A) Roll call by City Clerk;

(1B) At the discretion of the presiding officer, a reading of the Land Acknowledgement

(1C) At the discretion of the presiding officer, a flag salute;

(1D) At the discretion of the presiding officer, a Moment of Silence;

- (2) Approval of the Agenda
- (3) Closed Session (if any);
- (4) Presentations/Announcements;
- (5) General Public Comment;
- (6) General Administration Information;
- (7) Consent Calendar Items;
- (8) Public Hearings;
- (9) Regular Agenda Action Items;
- (10) Council Comments/Future Agenda Items, including:
 - (A) Reports on Regional Boards, Commissions, Committees
 - (B) Travel/Training Expenditures Disclosure
- (11) Adjournment.

b. Matters listed under the consent calendar are to be considered to be routine by the City Council and may be adopted by one motion. There will be no discussion of separate consent calendar items, unless a council member or members, or the staff requests specific items to be discussed or removed from the consent calendar for separate action.

c. Every agenda for regular meetings shall include the following statement at the beginning of the agenda:

The Elk Grove City Council welcomes, appreciates, and encourages participation in the City Council Meeting. The City Council requests that you limit your presentation to three (3) minutes per person, per item, so that all present will have time to participate. The City Council reserves the right to reasonably limit the total time for public comment on any particular noticed agenda item as it may deem necessary.

In accordance with Government Code section 54954.3(b), the following guidelines are adopted concerning public comment at regular meetings:

(1) No individual speaker may address the City Council for more than three (3) minutes per each agendized item.

(2) Regarding Public Comment on agendized items, speakers physically present at the meeting location will be called first, and remaining speakers signed up for Public Comment on that item will be heard next.

(3) These limits are guidelines and may either be strictly enforced or waived by the City Council in the discretion of the Mayor or by vote of the City Council, depending upon the nature of the discussion, the total amount of business to be considered at the particular meeting, the hour of the day, and other relevant factors.

4. Agenda

a. An agenda shall be prepared by the City Clerk before each meeting of the City Council.

b. For regular City Council meetings, the following shall apply:

(1) The agenda shall be prepared and posted at least 72 hours before the scheduled start of the regular meeting.

(2) The agenda shall be posted by the City Clerk, or authorized designee, consistent with the Brown Act. After the agenda is posted, the person who posted the agenda shall complete and sign a declaration of posting of agenda in a form to be provided by the City Attorney. The original of each declaration shall be maintained in a separate file by the City Clerk.

(3) The agenda shall specify the time and location of the regular meeting and shall contain a brief general description of each item of business to be transacted or discussed at the meeting.

5. Reconsideration

a. Actions of the City Council may be reconsidered within six months, only upon direction to the City Manager by a majority of Council members who are eligible to participate on the item. An action is defined as one wherein an item is agendized, considered, and a definitive action, by vote, is taken by the Council.

6. New Business: Introduction.

a. No new business of the City Council shall be considered after 10 p.m. Any new business remaining on the agenda shall be carried over to the next regular City Council meeting, or the meeting may be adjourned to a date specific at Council's direction.

7. Suspension of Rules


