

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-100

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL PROCEDURE PURSUANT TO ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.140(B)(3) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH THE COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE EXTENDING THE TERM THROUGH JUNE 30, 2027, AND INCREASING THE TOTAL COST BY AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$398,000 TO COVER THE ANNUAL SALARY COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE ADDITIONAL TERM (FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,472,000)

WHEREAS, the County of Sacramento District Attorney's Office (DA's Office) operates a Community Prosecution Program to solve problems, ensure public safety, address nuisances, and enhance quality of life in areas where a Community Prosecutor is assigned; and

WHEREAS, the Community Prosecution Program focuses on targeted areas and involves a long-term proactive partnership between the DA, law enforcement, the community, and public and private organizations; and

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2023, the City of Elk Grove (City) entered into a three-year contract with the DA's Office for Community Prosecution Program services through June 30, 2026, (Contract) as a resource for the Elk Grove community; and

WHEREAS, in July 2024, the City and the DA's Office entered into a first amendment to the Contract to allow for annual salary adjustments for the Community Prosecution Program; and

WHEREAS, the City has been highly satisfied with the partnership and desires to continue the Community Prosecution Program for an additional one-year term through June 30, 2027, and increase the total contract cost by an amount not to exceed \$398,000 to cover the salary costs associated with the additional term; and

WHEREAS, for the reasons presented, staff recommends that the City Council find that the formal request for proposal procedure required for procurement of professional or consultant services with a value in excess of \$50,000 is not in the best interest of the City.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby dispenses with the formal request for proposal procedure pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.140(B)(3) and authorizes the City Manager to execute the Second Amendment to the contract with the County of Sacramento for the Community Prosecution Program, in substantially the form presented, allowing for an additional one-year term through June 30, 2027, and increasing the total compensation by an amount not to exceed \$398,000 to provide for the annual salary costs associated with the additional term (*for a total contract amount not to exceed \$1,472,000*).
