

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-101

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL PROCEDURE PURSUANT TO ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.188(B)(3), AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE EIGHTH AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH SUPERION, LLC FOR CENTRAL SQUARE SOFTWARE PRODUCTS AND SERVICES, EXTENDING THE TERM FOR FIVE YEARS AND ADDING \$2,735,509.33 (FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$11,769,392.08), AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE FURTHER CONTRACT AMENDMENTS FOR AN ADDITIONAL \$500,000 OVER THE TERM OF THE EXTENSION FOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES AS MAY BE NEEDED

WHEREAS, in 2003 the City of Elk Grove (City) issued a formal Request for Proposal for the purchase of Citywide software and Superior, LLC (Central Square Technologies) was awarded Contract No. C-03-145; and

WHEREAS, the City has used this software for over 22 years as its Citywide software program to house centralized data that is accessed by over 300 staff members from every department; and

WHEREAS, City staff have spent numerous hours making improvements to processes and continuously looking for ways to better serve residents with the software; and

WHEREAS, the City completed a review of the system in 2022 and determined that best practices are being met and the current software meets the needs of staff; and

WHEREAS, this eighth amendment, extending the term for five years through June 30, 2031, will provide continuity of City services and processes; and

WHEREAS, costs for this extension have been included in the proposed Information Services budget for FY 2026-27, and costs for future years will be included in the respective fiscal year budgets, subject to City Council approval; and

WHEREAS, for the reasons presented, a formal request for proposal procedure for these subject services is not in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby dispenses with the formal request for proposal procedure pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.188(B)(3) and authorizes the City Manager to execute the eighth amendment to the contract with Superior, LLC for Central Square software products and services, in substantially the form presented, extending the term for five years and adding \$2,735,509.33 (for a total contract amount not to exceed \$11,769,392.08);


