**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL PROCEDURE
PURSUANT TO ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.188(B)(3) AND
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO
THE CONTRACT FOR SERVICES WITH INTERCEPT SECURITY FOR UNARMED
SECURITY GUARD SERVICES, EXTENDING THE TERM THROUGH JULY 1, 2027,
AND ADDING \$60,000 TO THE TOTAL CONTRACT COMPENSATION (FOR A
TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$234,000)**

WHEREAS, on June 12, 2024, the City Council authorized the City Manager to execute a Contract for Services with Intercept Security for unarmed security guard services for City of Elk Grove (City) facility rentals, special events, and related operations; and

WHEREAS, the Contract for Services established a two-year term with a total compensation amount of \$174,000; and

WHEREAS, the City continues to require unarmed security guard services to support City-owned facilities, facility rentals, special events, and related operations; and

WHEREAS, the proposed First Amendment to the Contract for Services would extend the contract term through July 1, 2027, and increase the total compensation amount by \$60,000, for a revised total contract amount not to exceed \$234,000; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funding for these services is included in the annual District56 Community Center operating budget; and

WHEREAS, Intercept Security was competitively selected through a formal Request for Proposals process completed in 2024, has provided satisfactory services, and continuation of services will ensure operational continuity for City facility rentals, special events, and related operations; and

WHEREAS, Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.188(B)(3) authorizes the City Council to dispense with the formal request for proposal procedure when it finds such a procedure is not in the best interest of the City and, for the reasons presented, the City Council finds that pursuing formal request for proposal procedure is not in the best interest of the City.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby dispenses with the formal request for proposal procedure pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.188(B)(3) and authorizes the City Manager to execute the First Amendment to the Contract for Services with Intercept Security for unarmed security guard services, in substantially the form presented, extending the contract term through July 1, 2027, and increasing the total compensation amount by \$60,000 for a total contract amount not to exceed \$234,000.
