

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-115

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL PROCEDURE PURSUANT TO ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.140(B)(3) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO 1) EXECUTE A COOPERATIVE SERVICE AGREEMENT AND FISCAL YEAR 2026-27 WORK AND FINANCIAL PLAN BETWEEN THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AND THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, ANIMAL AND PLANT HEALTH INSPECTION SERVICE – WILDLIFE SERVICES; 2) EXECUTE THE ANNUAL WORK AND FINANCIAL PLANS FOR THE FIVE-YEAR TERM OF THE AGREEMENT; AND 3) EXECUTE FUTURE RENEWALS, EXTENSIONS, AMENDMENTS, OR SUCCESSOR AGREEMENTS, AS WELL AS THE ASSOCIATED ANNUAL WORK AND FINANCIAL PLANS, ALL IN AMOUNTS NOT TO EXCEED THE AMOUNTS APPROVED FOR THESE SERVICES BY THE CITY COUNCIL WITH THE ANNUAL BUDGET PROCESS

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove (City) and United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service – Wildlife Services (APHIS-WS) entered into a five-year Cooperative Service Agreement (Agreement) in 2021 for wildlife management services; and

WHEREAS, APHIS-WS has expertise in conducting wildlife damage management activities to assist the City in minimizing damage to property, waterways and flood structures that may be caused by beavers; and

WHEREAS, Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.140(B)(3) provides that the City Council may dispense with the formal request for proposal procedure when it finds that the procedure is not in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, a formal request for proposal process is not in the best interest of the City because it is unlikely to result in a more advantageous outcome given the specialized nature of wildlife damage management and the demonstrated capability of the APHIS-WS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby dispenses with the formal request for proposal procedure pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.140(B)(3) and authorizes the City Manager to execute a Cooperative Service Agreement with the United States Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service – Wildlife Services with an effective date of July 1, 2026, and an expiration date of June 30, 2031, and a Work and Financial Plan for Fiscal Year 2026-27, in substantially the forms presented, in an amount not to exceed the amount approved for these services by the City Council with the Fiscal Year 2026-27 Budget;

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute the annual Work and Financial Plans for the five-year term of the Agreement through June 30, 2031, all in amounts not to exceed the amounts approved for these services by the City Council with the annual budget process;


AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute future renewals, extensions, amendments, or successor agreements, as well as the associated annual Work and Financial Plans, for substantially similar ongoing wildlife management services, all in amounts not to exceed the amounts approved for these services by the City Council with the annual budget process.
