

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-137

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL PROCEDURE PURSUANT TO ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.188(B)(3) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH LES SCHWAB TIRE CENTER OF CALIFORNIA, INC. (C-21-302) FOR NEW TIRE AND AUTOMOTIVE SERVICES, INCLUDING ROADSIDE TIRE SERVICES, EXTENDING THE CONTRACT TERM THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2026, AND INCREASING THE CONTRACT AUTHORITY BY \$150,000 FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$675,000

WHEREAS, Les Schwab Tire Center of California, Inc. (Les Schwab) has successfully provided tire and automotive services for City-owned vehicles since 2011, and continuation of these services will help ensure uninterrupted fleet operations, reduce vehicle downtime, and provide timely tire replacement, repair, and roadside tire services for City-owned vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the current contract expires on June 30, 2026, and staff has completed a formal request for proposal for tire and automotive services that is anticipated to be presented to the City Council at a future meeting, once the new agreement(s) has been finalized; and

WHEREAS, extending the contract term through December 31, 2026, and increasing the contract authority by \$150,000 is necessary to ensure uninterrupted tire and automotive services for City-owned vehicles while the City completes the procurement and implementation of a replacement contract; and

WHEREAS, to avoid the possibility of service interruptions, increased vehicle downtime, and reduced operational readiness of City-owned vehicles, staff recommends the City Council find that pursuing a formal request for proposal procedure for the continuation of tire and automotive services is not in the best interest of the City, pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.188(B)(3).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby dispenses with the formal request for proposal procedure pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.188(B)(3), and authorizes the City Manager to execute the Second Amendment to the contract with Les Schwab Tire Center of California, Inc., in substantially the form presented, extending the contract term through December 31, 2026, and increasing the contract authority by \$150,000 (for a total contract amount not to exceed \$675,000).
