**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL PROCEDURE
PURSUANT TO ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.188(B)(3) AND
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE THIRD AMENDMENT TO
THE CONTRACT WITH A-1 TOWING SERVICE, LLC, FOR VEHICLE TOW AND
STORAGE SERVICES, EXTENDING THE TERM THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2026,
AND INCREASING THE TOTAL COMPENSATION BY \$4,500
(FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$112,500)**

WHEREAS, Elk Grove Police Department (EGPD) investigates various crimes and motor vehicle accidents that occur within the City of Elk Grove (City) that require vehicles to be towed and held in a secure indoor facility at times; and

WHEREAS, EGPD also tows vehicles within the City for various types of traffic violations; and

WHEREAS, on June 24, 2020, the City entered into a three-year contract with A-1 Towing Service, LLC (A-1 Towing) for vehicle tow and storage services (Contract), as amended in 2022 (First Amendment) and in 2023, extending the term through June 30, 2026 (Second Amendment); and

WHEREAS, in May 2026, staff publicly announced a Request for Proposals (RFP) seeking evidence towing and storage services, and a separate Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for tow rotational services for vehicles requested to be towed and/or stored by EGPD; and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure continuity of services while the formal procurement process is completed, staff desires to extend the Contract with A-1 Towing for an additional three-month period through September 30, 2026, and increase the total contract amount by \$4,500 (for a total contract amount not to exceed \$112,500) to cover the costs for the additional three-month term; and

WHEREAS, for the reasons presented, staff recommends that the City Council find that the formal request for proposal procedure required for procurement of general services with a value in excess of \$50,000 is not in the best interest of the City pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.188(B)(3).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby dispenses with the formal request for proposal procedure pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code section 3.42.188(B)(3) and authorizes the City Manager to execute the third amendment to the contract with A-1 Towing Service, LLC, for vehicle tow and storage services, in substantially the form presented, allowing for an additional three-month term through September 30, 2026, and increasing the total compensation by \$4,500 (for a total contract amount not to exceed \$112,500).
