

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-141

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCEDURE PURSUANT TO ELK
GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.180(B)(4) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY
MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH L.N. CURTIS AND SONS
FOR POLICE UNIFORMS AND ALTERATIONS IN AN AMOUNT
NOT TO EXCEED \$513,396.82 THROUGH MARCH 4, 2031**

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove Police Department (EGPD) requires sworn and non-sworn staff to wear uniforms, logoed apparel, and requires alteration services to support departmental operations and maintain uniform standards; and

WHEREAS, from May 2018 through June 2026, the City has contracted with L.N. Curtis and Sons to secure competitively priced, quality products and alteration services; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.180(B)(4), the City Council may dispense with the formal bidding procedure when the purchase of commodities and equipment is processed through a cooperative purchasing agreement that is substantially consistent with the provisions of the City's purchasing procedures; and

WHEREAS, the League of Oregon Cities has secured a cooperative agreement with L.N. Curtis and Sons for law enforcement uniforms and equipment through a competitive process substantially similar to the City's purchasing provisions; and

WHEREAS, the proposed contract term aligns with the term of the cooperative purchasing agreement, and L.N. Curtis and Sons has offered pricing to the City that is more favorable than the pricing available through the cooperative purchasing agreement while agreeing to execute the City's standard contract; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that utilizing the cooperative purchasing agreement will provide cost savings, maintain continuity of service and uniform standards, and that conducting a separate competitive solicitation would not provide a material benefit to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby dispenses with the formal bidding procedure pursuant to EGMC 3.42.180(B)(4) and 3.42.220 and authorizes the City Manager to:


1. Execute a contract with L.N. Curtis and Sons for police uniforms, logoed apparel, and alteration services in an amount not to exceed \$513,396.82 through March 4, 2031; and
2. Execute all future amendments to the agreement concerning extensions of time, increases to individual unit costs as allowed by the contract, and the addition of new products required to meet the needs of the City, provided that such amendments do not result in an increase to the total compensation paid to L.N. Curtis and Sons.
