

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-128

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL PROCEDURE PURSUANT TO ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.140(B)(3) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH HINDERLITER, DE LLAMAS & ASSOCIATES DBA HDL COMPANIES, A CALIFORNIA CORPORATION, EXTENDING THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT BY ONE YEAR THROUGH JUNE 30, 2027, WITH NO CHANGE TO THE PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT OF \$342,517

WHEREAS, on August 25, 2021, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove (City) approved an agreement with Hinderliter, de Llamas & Associates dba HdL Companies (HdL) for tax consulting services; and

WHEREAS, on February 22, 2023, the City Council approved the first amendment to the agreement to provide Utility User Tax Administration and Transactions and Use Tax Consulting Services, including authority for HdL to examine Transactions and Use Tax records maintained by the California Department of Tax and Fee Administration (CDTFA); and

WHEREAS, HdL currently provides Utility User Tax administration, Transactions and Use Tax consulting, auditing, forecasting, and revenue analysis services that support the City's budget development and long-range financial planning efforts; and

WHEREAS, the current agreement expires on June 30, 2026, and staff recommends extending the term of the agreement through June 30, 2027; and

WHEREAS, the proposed second amendment extends the term of the agreement only and does not increase the total compensation previously authorized by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, for the reasons presented, staff recommends that the City Council find that a formal request for proposal procedure is not in the best interest of the City pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.140(B)(3).


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby dispenses with the formal request for proposal procedure pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.140(B)(3) and authorizes the City Manager to execute the Second Amendment to the contract with Hinderliter, de Llamas & Associates dba HdL Companies, a California Corporation, in substantially the form presented, for specialized tax consulting and administration services, extending the term of the agreement through June 30, 2027, with no change to the previously authorized total contract amount of \$342,517.


