**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A TWO-YEAR CONTRACT
WITH CAPITOL ADVOCACY FOR STATE GOVERNMENT RELATIONS SERVICES
WITH A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT OF \$120,000**

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove (City) conducted a formal Request for Proposals (“RFP”) process to solicit qualified providers for the State Government Relations Services contemplated by this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, following evaluation of the proposals received in accordance with the City’s established criteria and procedures, Capitol Advocacy was determined to be the most qualified and best-value provider of such services; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to contract with Capitol Advocacy for State Government Relations Services; and

WHEREAS, Capitol Advocacy is a highly respected government relations firm in California; familiar with the goals and priorities of the City, as well as the City’s state legislative delegation and staff; and

WHEREAS, the City Council and staff will work closely with Capitol Advocacy on various initiatives, including general bill monitoring and tracking, grant advocacy, as well as specific legislative changes.




